Dear All,

Greetings from Fortaleza, Brazil. We are continuing to see God's blessing and transformation He causes through His great and powerful Word. Our class of 2008 has gone though some wonderful experiences as we have studied the Word of God. We are continuing the program of School of the Bible. God has given us a small but very impressive group of students this year.



During this year we have accomplished our normal outreach activities. In February, YWAM – Fortaleza (including School of the Bible students and staff) traveled to Recife to the Carnaval outreach. Most of the YWAM bases in the Northeast and some of local churches gathered together in Recife for this years outreach. Between 300 to 400 Christians gathered together to evangelize for the Gospel of Christ. This entire group shared the gospel with literally thousands of people celebrating the Carnaval.



Our second outreach in June this year was in the interior of Piauí, a neighboring state here in the Northeast of Brazil. We call this a teaching outreach because the goal is to give the students experience in teaching the Bible with the material they learned during the course. We traveled almost a day of traveling to get to the area where we ministered. The climate in this area is very simliar to Arizona - hot and dry. The team traveled to three small cities and churches: Christian Evangelical Church in São Raimundo do Nato (30,000), São Lourenço Assembly of God in São Lourenço (3,000), and Renewal Christian Evangelico Church, in Canto de Buriti. Our main focus was teaching seminars in these churches, but we also did some evangelism efforts.

In these churches we mainly focused on ministering in seminars and teaching in the services. We addressed subjects such as Evangelism, Christian living, purpose and design of man, Christ, the Character of God, Sin, Salvation, and other subjects also. The people were very impacted because we shared some very basic biblical truths that are vital to our life with Christ.

We saw some interesting things in our times of evangelism. The interior of Brazil has very strong Catholic influence, as well as the religion of Spiritism and other interesting beliefs intertwined within the culture. Twice we came across demonic manifestations (See more about this in my website at www.disciplenations.com). When I think of this it reminds me of the verse: "When

the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he walketh through **dry places**, seeking rest, and findeth none." (Mt 12:43 AV) I have not had a lot of contact with this type of thing, but when I think of the climate, this verse brings interesting input to our experiences.

The testimony of one of our students about the outreach:

"In relation to the outreach, I was feeling as if we ourselves were the disciples commissioned by Christ himself. We were able to go out in His name, healing people, casting out demons, and transforming the lives of people. I can certainly speak for the entire team that we are very grateful that God has entrusted us to carry His name."

Asia Outreach

Many of you have experienced the opening ceremony of the Olympics. What a marvelous display of the excellence and potential of the people of Asia. God had spoken to me before the beginning of the School of the Bible about the going to Asia. I had never had any desire for that place in my life. But now we are going, God willing, to Asia on the School of the Bible outreach in November. We believe that God has called us to support and encourage the churches there. Certainly with a scarcity of Bibles, we will be able to fulfill the need for knowledge and training of Biblical truths.

Our team faces a lot of challenges for our students and for myself. We are going to have to raise a good amount of money to cover our personal cost. Six people going to Asia is about \$18,000. I feel that I should help and personally raise \$10000 toward this need to cover my own expenses as well as help out some other students. Because of the financial situation here in Brazil, it is not easy for some students to pay their school and to raise this type of money for global outreach.

The next school of the Bible is going to start in August of 2009. This will enable my family also to travel back to the States and to Enid's home in Puerto Rico. Also for traveling back to Puerto Rico and the States is going to cost at least \$5000 for my entire family (six people). Thanks in advance for considering these needs. Thanks for praying for us and blessing us financially.
